

Early Bird 13 Scholarship Application

Submission Deadline: See PCN website, Financial Aid

Scholarship Award: Selected recipient will receive \$1,300 off the total \$6,600 program fee.

Eligibility:

- Applicants must meet early bird date, a date prior to normal cohort application deadline.
- Applicant must complete all other program application requirements by early bird date to be eligible for scholarship award.
- Alumni are eligible to apply for both the Early Bird 13 and Alumni 13 Scholarships but may only be awarded one.
 - You may submit similar essay content for both applications if relevant to the specific questions.
 - o Be mindful of separate deadlines and requirements for each.

Applicant Requirements - All Steps Must Be Completed:

- 1. Pre-Requisite:
 - Complete the online application, including payment of the application fee.
- 2. Scholarship Cover Page:
 - Download and complete the cover page at the end of this document.
 - Save as: EARLYBIRD13CP_LAST NAME
- 3. Essay Responses:
 - Respond to all essay prompts in one Word document.
 - Format: 12 pt. Times New Roman, single-spaced, minimum 250 words per response.
 - Save as: EARLYBIRD13ER_LAST NAME
- 4. Recommendation Letter:
 - Obtain a letter of recommendation from your intended Campus Principal Mentor.
 - Save as: EARLYBIRD13RF_LAST NAME
- 5. Submission:
 - By the application deadline, email the completed cover page, essay responses, and recommendation letter together in one submission to: leadership@esc13.txed.net;
