

WANT TO START A HEALTH SCIENCE PROGRAM OF STUDY BUT DON'T KNOW WHERE TO START?



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YEAR 1

Start by offering Principles of Health Science

Start your Health Science Program by offering Principles of Health Science for 9th graders. Contract with a Region 13 instructor to teach this class.

YEAR 2

Continue building foundational knowledge with Medical Terminology

Continue offering 9th grade Health Science, and add a Medical Terminology class for 10th graders taught by one of your science teachers.

YEAR 3

Take it to the next level with a course on Anatomy & Physiology

Continue offering 9th grade Principles of Health Science, and 10th grade Medical Terminology; add an Anatomy & Physiology course for 11th graders taught by one of your science teachers.

YEAR 4

Lay the groundwork for post-graduation success by offering a Practicum in Health Science

In year four, continue teaching all prior courses and hire your own Health Science teacher. Offer an industry-based certification, such as medical-assisting, and improve your CCMR rating.
