## **Alternative Teacher Certification Checklist**

Before	Choose your desired grade levels/subjects.  Research alternative certification programs.  Decide on a program that fits the time frame, medium, and coursework that you want. ECP has several certification pathways you can explore.  Make sure you meet the requirements to be admitted into the program, as each program has specific criteria.
During	Develop a certification plan with the program, which will include:  Structured content preparation and testing  50 hours of field-based experience  150 hours of pedagogy training  Secure a teaching position.  It should be in your target certificate's grade level and subject area.  Apply for an Intern Certificate.  This certificate is only valid for one calendar year.  Your program must also recommend you for the certificate.  Complete all certification program requirements.  This includes the remaining coursework, training, and exam.  You are required to complete a minimum of 300 hours of training.  Have a successful internship year.  Pass the Pedagogy and Professional Responsibilities (PPR) exam.  Apply for a standard teaching certificate.  You must also have a recommendation from your certification program to apply.
After	Congrats! You are now a certified teacher.  You will receive an email from TEAL letting you know you have been recommended for your standard certificate.  You can also access your certificate on the TEAL website.
